



Harrington Grove

HARRINGTON Grove, set up five years ago, is a master planned residential section of the Harrington Park estate.

The development offers urban home sites - all blocks are 700sqm or larger - supported by facilities for the exclusive use of residents.

Laurina, the latest release, includes exclusive home sites in a natural bushland enclave with leafy outlooks.

Only 40 per cent of the Harrington Grove footprint will ever be developed - the remaining 60 per cent of the 450ha site will be restored as protected, once endangered, Cumberland Plain woodland.

The facilities include the Harrington Grove Country Club, swimming pools, tennis courts, gym, amphitheatre, community rooms, pathways and cycleways, two neighbourhood centres and fitness stations, all of which the residents are free to use.

Activities for residents include fun runs for charity, high tea, fairs and cocktail parties to meet the neighbours.

The Fairfax family owns the historical homestead - Harrington Park House - which was built around 1817 and recently restored.

They were strongly involved in working with Harrington Estates to develop the family-oriented vision for Harrington Park, and seeing it through to its fruition.

The Fairfax family is still strongly influential in the development of Harrington Grove and continues to have a strong presence in the area.

Harrington Grove was named Australian Residential Development of the Year 2014 by the Urban Development Institute of Australia (and NSW Residential Development of the Year 2013).
